

## VOLUNTARY ROLE: MEDICAL SUB-COMMITTEE

## Introduction

Volunteering as an England Boxing clubs & membership committee member, you will be **actively supporting at one of the highest levels** within the organisation, working centrally to **drive improvements** in how we do things. Committee members are responsible for encouraging participation in the sport of Boxing by means of education and training, and to improve the standards of safety in Boxing and competence of coaches in the sport.

This role provides a superb opportunity to learn more about **organisational management at a national level** and will provide you with an **unrivalled network of contacts across England Boxing** and beyond. The committee meets every other month virtually to discuss medical issues arising from England Boxing as well as future medical policy.

The committee reports directly to the England Boxing Board and is chaired by England Boxing director Dr Doniert Macfarlane.

We are an inclusive organisation, and encourage applications for anyone, whether you're a member of England Boxing or not. Areas of expertise that we are looking for include people development, safeguarding (including from other sports), and development / QA of qualifications.

## The Role

- The medical sub-committee is looking for three new members to replace retiring committee members.
- The medical sub-committee meets every two months via Zoom, to discuss medical issues arising from England Boxing and discuss future medical policy.

- The ideal candidate would be currently active on the England Boxing ringside circuit, with at least three years' experience of the role as essential criteria.
- Desirable criteria would be relevant additional clinical experience as an expert in a particular field of medicine applicable to boxing.
- This is a voluntary role and requires one hour per month on average of members' time.

This is a voluntary (unpaid) position, but reasonable out-of-pocket expenses will be reimbursed for travel to meetings, etc, although meetings generally take place online via Zoom or Microsoft Teams.
