

ENGLAND BOXING COMMUNITY APPRENTICESHIP (LEVEL 3) FAQ'S

- Q. How many hours will I be expected to work during the week?
- A. The EB Community Apprenticeship is a full-time position for 15 months that will see you work 35 hours per week which includes 7hr of learning time as part of the level 3 qualification
- Q. What qualification will I gain through the apprenticeship?
- A. The apprenticeship includes the completion of a Community Sport and Health Officer (Level 3) qualification, provided through our partnership with <u>Lifetime Training</u> and <u>Coach Core</u>
- Q. What will be provided in terms of career support post-apprenticeship?
- A. Our apprenticeship programme includes opportunities throughout the 15-month period including career fairs, championship & event support, social media & comms, business admin experience, and opening up opportunities with other sports sector employers etc...
- Q. Will I be expected to work from the England Boxing office in Sheffield?
- A. Our apprentices will primarily work from our head offices in Sheffield, but outreach work at local boxing clubs, community facilities and occasional opportunities to work from home will be possible. There will be meetings/training opportunities that will be based at England Boxing's office in Sheffield, as well as other locations throughout the country during the term of the apprenticeship
- Q. What is the salary?
- A. Our apprentice will be paid £7.50 per hour which is above the national apprenticeship wage (currently £6.40 per hour) for the first 12 months, rising to NMW for the final 3 months of the apprenticeship



- Q. Will I get the opportunity to gain any additional qualifications during the apprenticeship?
- A. Yes, you will undertake the England Boxing Level 1 Coaching course and will also be provided with other training opportunities such as the Boxing Activator Course and EB Officiating course
