WOMEN'S WINTER BOX CUP

KEY INFORMATION
CIRCULAR



Welcome to the key information circular for the **Women's Winter Box Cup 2024**, to be held at Leigh Leisure Centre, WN7 4JY on Saturday 30th November (Semi Finals) and Sunday 1st December (Finals) 2024.

Leigh Leisure Centre provides free parking for vehicles onsite. Please ensure that all vehicles are parked considerately within the marked bays.

This event is open to female boxers born between 01/01/1984 and 31/12/2009, in a wide range of weight categories ranging from Under 46kg to Over 81kg.

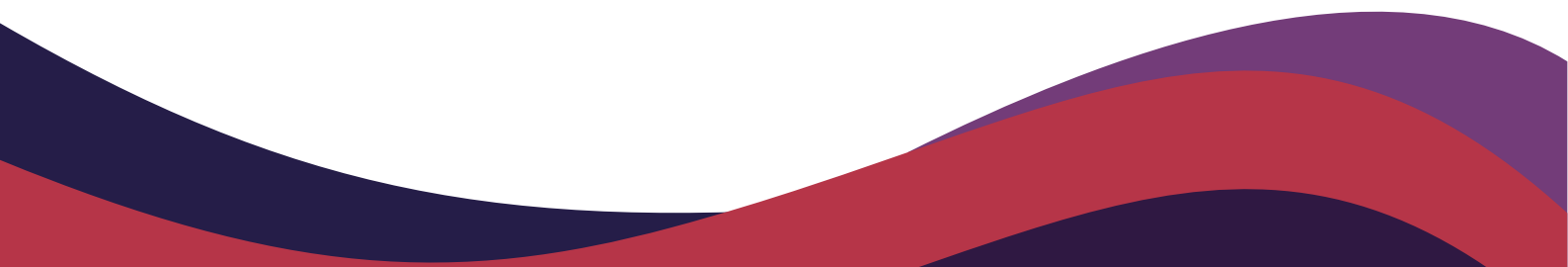

ACCREDITATION/WEIGHING IN

Accreditation and weighing in for boxers will take place at Leigh Leisure Centre, Sale Way, Leigh Sports Village, Leigh, WN7 4JY between **8:00am - 10:00am** on both Saturday 30th November and Sunday 1st December.

Boxers and coaches must be at the venue in good time to be weighed in and to carry out their pre bout medicals. The scales will **close at 10:00am prompt** on both days.

Please note that **all boxers must weigh in on Saturday 30th November**, and only those that progress to the finals on Sunday 1st December.



Please be advised that any boxer who does not weigh-in and attend the medical on the days they are required to do so will be withdrawn from the competition.


All boxers must bring their BCRI medical cards (or international equivalent) and gumshields with them (no red or partially red) to the initial weigh-in and to all subsequent rounds. Due to the number of boxers entered in this event, only one coach of the same gender from any one club will be allowed to enter the weigh-in room with their boxer(s).

Each morning during accreditation, boxers and coaches will receive their daily accreditation wristbands. Boxers and coaches will need to show their wristband to access the field of play and other areas within the venue such as the allocated warm up areas. **In addition to their wristband, coaches must always wear their current England Boxing coaching lanyard (or international equivalent).**

BOXER REQUIREMENTS

All boxers must be registered with an England Boxing affiliated club or in the case of international entrants must be registered with their National Federation (and have authorisation to participate).

Each boxer's medical must be in date for the duration of the WWBC 2024. Boxers from outside England must have a medical recorded in their record books in accordance with their National Federation. Any boxer who's medical expires before the end of the tournament will be withdrawn.



All England Boxing registered boxers must ensure the following items are up to date in the Locker in preparation for the Women's Winter Box Cup 2024:

- Profile picture uploaded showing only the boxer (passport style).
- Digital BCRI Red QR code ready on your device. To get a valid QR code you'll need:
 1. Current age verification uploaded
 2. Current membership registered to an England Boxing club
 3. No medical suspensions
 4. Pregnancy indemnity form (if applicable).
- Current, in-date medical covering the entire duration of the event.
- Declaration of all previous combat and EB bouts.

Boxers from outside England will be required to declare themselves non-pregnant on each day of the competition, failure to do so will result in the boxer being withdrawn from the competition. Non-pregnancy is to be declared at the weigh-in each day by the submission of the following female declaration forms – please complete and print in advance;

England Boxing will provide appropriate [headguards](#) and [gloves](#) for all contests throughout the semifinals and finals. Only IBA approved [hand wraps](#) must be worn (with limited quantities available for purchase at the venue).

In accordance with IBA rules a bandana or hair net must be worn to ensure hair is secure throughout the bout. Any false eyelashes or nails must be removed prior to boxing.

COACH REQUIREMENTS

All coaches must be a member of England Boxing or their National Federation, have authorisation to participate, and be registered on the WWBC 2024 entry system.

All England Boxing registered coaches must ensure the following items are up to date in the Locker in preparation for the Women's Winter Box Cup 2024:

- Profile picture uploaded showing only the coach (passport style).
- Digital purple Coach Licence QR code on your device. To get a valid QR code you'll need:
 1. Current membership registered to an England Boxing club
 2. In-date First Aid certificate
 3. In-date Safeguarding certificate
 4. In-date DBS certificate.
- Coach's physical lanyard (to be worn at all times).

No coach will be granted accreditation without displaying a current and fully in-date lanyard (or international equivalent) with valid First Aid, DBS and Safeguarding dates.

The number of accredited coaches eligible for this competition is based on the number of entered boxers as follows;

- 1 boxer = 3 coaches
- 2 boxers = 4 coaches
- 3 or more boxers = 6 coaches
- Only 3 coaches are permitted to second a boxer.

Please note the numbers above will be strictly enforced during accreditation, in accordance with the regulations outlined [2023 - 2024 England Boxing Rule Book](#).

BOXING TIMINGS

On Saturday 30th November boxing will commence at **12:30pm**.
On Sunday 1st December boxing will commence at **11:00am**.

A 30-minute interval will take place in each ring at a specified time, outlined on the finalised bout lists.

Bouts will commence from lightest weight categories ascending; Juniors, Youths, Seniors.

PROGRAMME

The official draw will take place on completion of the weigh-in on Saturday 30th November and will be announced on the England Boxing [website](#), and on England Boxing's social media channels, on completion.

Where the number of entries per weight category exceeds four, the boxers will split into two or more groups at that weight.

Please note that the programme will be dependent on all boxers making the weight and passing the doctor's examination.

The confirmed bout order for each day will be promulgated on completion of the draw for the semifinals and, following those results, for the finals.

There will be three boxing rings in place on all days.

BOXING TIMINGS

Spectator tickets are to be purchased through the England Boxing Online Box Office in advance of the event (click [here](#) or scan the QR code below to access).

We strongly recommend purchasing tickets in advance of travelling to ensure entry on the day, and fast track the queues. A limited number of tickets **may** be available at the door (card payments only), subject to capacity.

- Age requirements and valid ID checks will apply to all ticket holders.
- Tickets are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and non-refundable.
- Children and juniors must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Damaged or broken wristbands will not be replaced. Swapping or exchanging wristbands is strictly prohibited and will result in refused entry.
- Tickets can only be redeemed on the day(s) they are valid for.

Wristbands will be issued to spectators after showing a valid ticket at the entrance, either directly from your smartphone, or a printed version of the original ticket.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Please note that England Boxing photographers and videographers will be capturing footage on both days of the event that may include capturing images of spectators. By attending as a spectator, you agree this imagery and videography can be used by England Boxing and other media outlets.

Any spectator wishing to take photos or videos with professional equipment who is not accredited with England Boxing will be required to sign a photography permission form on arrival. These will be available at the England Boxing ticket desk.
